


Pacific Rundum Commits to Reducing Greenhouse Gas Emissions

Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Emissions Reduction Targets

Scope of emissions	Definition	2030 target
Scope 1	Direct GHG emissions from enterprise (typically fossil fuel combustion and industrial processes)	50% reduction in GHG emissions (Scope 1 + 2) relative to 2018 levels
Scope 2	Indirect emissions associated with use of electricity, heat and/or steam from external suppliers	
Scope 3	Other indirect emissions generated by external suppliers in enterprise value chain	Calculate emission levels and design reduction strategies
